As business travel and growing numbers of dispersed or mobile workers continue to accelerate the pace of the work environment, collaboration tools become increasingly critical to productivity.

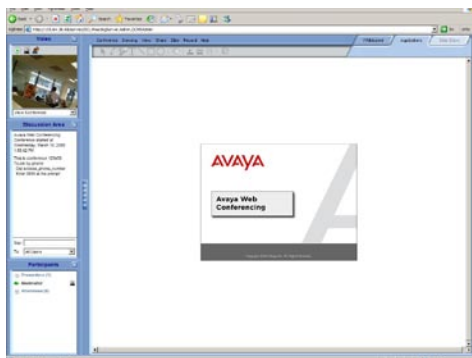

Solution Overview

A single-window, browser-based application, Avaya Web Conferencing makes it easy for participants — inside or outside the firewall — to join conferences and avoid the need to download applications or client software. A conference URL and security code are all that's required. And, because the solution optimizes bandwidth for each user, slower connections, like dial-up, do not hinder overall meeting performance.

Avaya Web Conferencing can be branded and customized based on your preferences.

Avaya Web Conferencing provides the following tools to make virtual meetings more interactive and productive:



- PowerPoint “push”, document annotation, white boarding, text chat, and polling with instant tabulation
- Desktop and application sharing, ideal for live product demonstrations or interactive document review and editing
- Streamed video from presenters using a simple USB webcam
- Roster display of participants
- Discussion window that provides keyboard chatting that can be private between individuals or broadcast and visible to all
- Promotion capability that enables a host to promote a participant to “host” status so participant can control the Web conference
- Recording and playback of audio and Web portions of the conference¹
- LDAP Integration of corporate directories and databases



Integrated Audio and Web Conferencing

Integrating Avaya Web Conferencing with Meeting Exchange audio conferencing enhances the meeting experience by enabling hosts to monitor and control the activity of participants in the conference. An integrated participant roster, that appears in the Web Conference interface, provides these capabilities:

- Access audio and Web portions of the conference with a single set of login credentials
- Identify speakers — or noisy lines — in the audio conference
- Mute individuals or the entire audience
- Disconnect participants
- Dial out to bring in additional participants
- Force disconnect of individual participant
- Start and stop synchronized recording of the conference
- Synchronize recording of combined web and audio

Secure Meetings

Unlike Web conferencing services, Avaya Web Conferencing ensures control of accounts and usage on the system because it is deployed on the corporate network in accordance with internal IT policies. The firewall-friendly solution is deployed using SSL security and encryption for more secure meetings. Firewall friendly deployment allows you to choose whether or not access to Avaya Web Conferencing is made available to internal users only or to both internal and external users.

Conference Recording and Playback

The optional conferencing recording and playback feature of Avaya Web Conferencing allows users to simultaneously record the complete meeting including the audio proceedings, slide show, application sharing, and white boarding.

Administrators can ensure the security of recorded meetings they post by permitting or prohibiting user access as appropriate. Meetings can be replayed via the Web using a local media player.

Many customers who implement Avaya Web Conferencing on an existing infrastructure realize a rapid return-on-investment – reducing monthly conferencing expenses by up to 50% – when compared to Web conferencing services that impose per-use and recurring fees.
